### **Woodland Hills Juvenile Justice program accepts youth who are:**

- Males and females who are between the ages of 12-18 (up through 21 if designated EJJ)
- IQ of 70 or above without a diagnosis of intellectual disability
- Stable thought disorders
- Able to participate in peer group activities
- Low-risk for unhealthy sexual behavior
- Low to moderate risk for elopement
- Low to moderate risk for aggression

### **Cambia Hills Mental Health Residential accepts youth who are:**

- Males and females who are between the ages of 10 - 17
- IQ of 70 or above without a diagnosis of intellectual disability
- Stable thought disorders
- Non-acute suicide risk
- Mild neuro-developmental disorders
- Function in group milieu
- Low risk of unhealthy sexual behavior
- Low to moderate risk for elopement
- Low to moderate risk for aggression

### **Cambia Hills Mental Health Day Treatment accepts youth who are:**

- Males and females who are between the ages of 12 - 17
- IQ of 70 or above without a diagnosis of intellectual disability
- Stable thought disorders
- Non-acute suicide risk
- Mild neuro-developmental disorders
- Participate in group process
- Low risk of unhealthy sexual behavior
- Low to moderate risk for aggression
